Yikáii Yizhchį Conference

This year's Yikáii Yizhchí Conference will center upon Fundamental Law: Diné Bibeehaz'áanii. Natural Law and Traditional Law were created in the Black World. These laws were severely violated and consequently, Naayéé' (Evil/Disease) came into existence. The violations of these laws could not be resolved. Through a miraculous birth came hope and resolution: Yoolgaii Asdzáá and the Warrior Twins. The Warrior Twins destroyed the Naayéé' and re-established Natural and Traditional Law. In addition, two more Fundamental Laws were created: Customary Law and Common Law. This year's conference will address the violations of Natural and Traditional Laws, regarding what the consequences were.

Such as how they were re-established and how all of these occurrences relate to us as a Navajo Nation: Government, Child Development, Family, Health (physical, mental, emotional) and Education. These will be presented all within the context of Yikáii Yizhchí.

In addition, this year's Conference will address the Fundamental Laws of our main ceremonies: Tł'ééjí, Na'at'ooyeejí, Diné BinĤch'ijí, Hózhójí. The Conference will address how the Fundamental Laws are embedded within our ceremonies and through our ceremonies, how they are related to and carried out into our daily Diné lives.
